A 6-week course, starting on Wednesday 19th January 2021, 8pm GMT [3pm EST]

The aim of this course is to provide a solid grounding in the health care of camelids. It will cover the crucial elements of managing alpacas and llamas as well as many common problems experienced. We will not deal specifically with any reproduction or neonatal problems in this course. It will therefore be applicable to owners of breeding and non-breeding animals.

Taught by the UK's only specialist camelid vet, you will be provided with the most up to date information to help you care for your animals. There will be ample opportunity for questions - there is no such thing as a stupid question!

Suitable for beginners as well as more experienced owners wanting a refresher course.

COURSE SCHEDULE:

- Session 1. 19th January General camelid management
- Session 2. 26th January Nutritional management
- Session 3. 2nd February Parasite control: worms, coccidia and fluke
- Session 4. 9th February Biosecurity for the farm
- Session 5. 23rd February Skin Problems
- Session 6. 2nd March Health Problems and what to do when things go wrong

Each session will last 1-1.5 hours including time for questions. **All sessions will be available as a recording** to view after the event (available for 4 months) in case you aren't able to attend.
